BUS ROUTES AND TIMETABLES

In 2018 we will be continuing with the Bryanston morning bus service for our learners. The bus leaves Rosebank at 06:15 every morning and arrives at the Bryanston Shopping Centre by 06:30. The bus waits at this stop until 06:40. The bus then continues to the Fury Ford/Woolworths (William Nicol) and leaves this stop at 06:55. The bus then proceeds to the Foundation Phase School and then onto Rosebank.

We will be introducing a new bus service in 2018 from St David's at 07:00 every morning to St Teresa's IP and High School and onto Foundation Phase.

These bus route and times are subject to change depending on demand.

BUS COSTS

Charges for the morning bus route are to remain unchanged and are as follows:

 Bryanston Route	R800.00 per term per child.
 St David's to St Teresa's	R600.00 per term per child.

School accounts will be debited termly. **One term's written notice** must be given to the Bursar's Office in the event of the learner discontinuing the use of this service. Cancellation of bus charges will only be processed if written notification is received by the Bursar's Office before the end of the notice term. We reserve the right to change the cost of the service on a termly basis, depending on the escalations in the diesel price. We also reserve the right to terminate this service should there be insufficient take-up of the service to make it feasible.

LOST PROPERTY

St Teresa's School's bus drivers will keep all property left on the bus to be collected the next morning. Anything not collected will be handed into the schools lost property depots.

APPLICATIONS

Application forms and indemnity forms are included at the back of this booklet. If you wish to make use of this service, please complete the form and email it to us. **All applications must be e-mailed to senior-primary@stteresas.co.za**. A separate form must be completed for each child. Please ensure that you indicate the stop number on the route that you wish to use.

Only 31 children can be accommodated on the bus.

As space is limited, the first applications emailed back to the address advertised, will be offered this service for 2017.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

1. The bus will always display the St Teresa's School name and badge.
2. The bus will have two drivers on each trip. These drivers are employed by the school and have a cell phone, so that we can contact them at all times.
3. The bus will leave promptly each day.
4. Please ensure that you are at the stop **5 minutes** before the scheduled time as the bus driver operates on a very tight schedule and cannot wait for you. Depending on traffic congestion, buses may run ahead or behind the estimated schedule. While all of the stops were chosen with the safety of the girls in mind, we strongly encourage all parents to wait with their child until the bus arrives. All of the stops have ample parking available for the parents to park and wait until such time as the bus arrives.

5. The school will keep an up-to-date record of all parents' contact numbers. If there are any unforeseen mechanical problems with the bus that may cause the bus to be delayed, we will contact you straight away.
6. If the school is aware that the bus is in need of repairs the day before a morning pick up, St Teresa's School will hire an alternative bus (at no extra cost to you) in order to enable the service to continue. If this occurs, all parents will be contacted the day before so that they are aware of the different bus that will be on the route the next day. All of these precautions are for the safety of your child.
7. The school driver is in charge of learners on the bus and they are required to listen to his instructions at all times. Any child deemed to break the rules on the bus will be called before the Principal. If a learner does not obey the driver, or does not behave in line with St Teresa's School's Code of Conduct, the school reserves the right to cancel this child's transportation on the morning bus service.
8. All children are to remain seated with their seatbelts fastened until the bus comes to a complete stop back in the Rosebank grounds.

OUR BUS AND DRIVERS-SAFETY FIRST

To ensure the safety of all learners travelling on the morning bus route, Parents can feel secure in the knowledge that St Teresa's only makes use of our own school bus which is regularly serviced and compliant with all safety regulations. The morning bus service is only operated by the school's two experienced bus drivers, Solomon and Alpheus. Having our two drivers on the bus every morning enables the girls to feel safe and secure as they travel to school.
