## **CULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP**

1. On receipt of an application form and a portfolio of evidence of cultural achievement, an interview will be scheduled at which the applicant will be required to demonstrate her skills in the discipline of choice, as detailed below.
2. **Applications close on Monday 17 February at 09h00** and interviews will be conducted between Tuesday 3, and, Friday 6 March 2020.
3. No award will be made if the level of skill and/or ability demonstrated is not high enough to justify it. The award is subject to the candidate maintaining a high standard of academic work, cultural achievement, and conduct.
4. The decision of the Bursary & Scholarship Committee in awarding this scholarship will be final and no correspondence will be entered into in this regard.
5. Mrs de Bod, the High School Principal, will notify the winners telephonically on 27 March 2020, and all candidates will receive a letter informing them of the winners. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the results of the interviews. The scholarship will commence at the beginning of 2021.
6. In making application, a detailed Grade 6 report will be required. In addition, any other talent displayed by the candidate should be mentioned. We reserve the right to request a letter of recommendation from the Head of the school which the candidate attends
7. Unsuccessful candidates are not under any obligation whatsoever to attend St Teresa's School.
8. Before making application parents should consult the Head of the school currently attended by their daughter.

10. The discipline of expertise, i.e. visual arts, or dramatic arts, must be taken as a subject to Matriculation level.

### **Dramatic arts:**

- An interview will be required.
- The applicant must present a prepared monologue and poem (published works).
- She may be requested to perform an unprepared piece.
- Proof of any previous involvement in dramatic arts and related activities is required.
- The applicant will be required to study dramatic arts as a Matriculation subject and participate in school productions.

## **Music:**

- An interview will be required.
- Applicants should arrive dressed in neutral black clothing.
- The applicant should have a musical curriculum vitae illustrating past participation.
- An audition will be held to determine standard of playing – minimum standard of performance must be comparable to Grade 4.
- A theory paper will be written comparable to Grade 2.
- The successful candidate should participate in school musical events.
- The applicant must have participated regularly, and for a sustained period in at least one music group activity, and must continue such activity at St Teresa's School, e.g. by joining the choir.
- The applicant will be required to study music throughout her schooling and complete the required external practical and theory examinations.

## **Visual arts:**

Portfolio requirements:

- A short, curriculum vitae is required describing the applicant's activities, spanning at least two years prior to date of application.
- Merits or certificates must be included on application.
- The applicant will be required to engage in:
  - A half-hour drawing session
  - A fifteen-minute interview
- A minimum of three most recent art works must be presented (not mounted or framed). Three different media must have been used: e.g. charcoal, watercolour, and oil, or mixed media.
- The applicant will be required to study Visual Arts as a Matriculation subject.

## **Contract of Enrolment to St Teresa's School**

1. I/We undertake to pay the School stipulated fees inclusive of related charges which are compulsory in accordance with the annual signed payment option document. Any late payment of any amounts due to the School, will attract a late payment charge, for the overdue amount/s outstanding. For security reasons no cash will be accepted at the School. Please deposit directly into our bank account using the correct reference and your surname when making the payment.
2. I/We acknowledge that the School reviews its fees and ancillary charges annually in the second half of each year and sends notifications out for the subsequent year's charges' two months before the end of the preceding year, once it has determined the increases applicable for the fees and ancillary charges for the subsequent year. I/We hereby bind myself/ourselves, to pay such School determined fees and related charges as and when they fall due for payment.
3. One full term's notice in writing is required should your daughter/s leave the School, which must be given by no later than the end of the first week of the term in which the child/ren will be leaving the School. A term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged and is agreed as the School's pre-estimated damages, if the requisite one full term's written notice not be given to the School.
4. If any amount payable to the School be overdue, the School shall be entitled to instruct its attorneys to attend to the collection of such overdue amounts inclusive of interest and costs. In the event of overdue amounts not being paid after demand by the School, the School reserves to itself the right to cancel the contract. In the event of the School instructing its attorneys to make demand or institute legal proceedings against any parent/guardian, I/We shall be liable for the attorneys' legal charges on the attorney and client scale, inclusive of collection commission, all disbursements incurred and tracing fees, irrespective of whether legal action is instituted or not for due compliance.
5. I/We hereby give permission for my/our daughter to participate in the normal sporting, cultural and religious activities of the School. I/We acknowledge that I/we shall have no claim against the School for injuries, or lost articles of clothing and goods or equipment that may be lost or damaged, howsoever arising and hereby indemnify the School against any claims the School may receive.
6. I/We accept and will support all the policy of the School including those relating to compulsory pupil attendances at School and extra-mural activities, and will not ask for permission to extend vacations nor make doctors, dentist or driving licence appointments for my/our daughter during normal school hours and the School term.
7. I/We understand and accept the School's fee structures and my/our accountability for paying the fees and related charges and ancillary amounts as they fall due for payment and the methods of payment.
8. I/We accept that if this application is successful it will be in terms of the general conditions governing the School's admissions and the School's code of conduct and rules (a copy of which is available in the school office at any time). I/We acknowledge and bind myself/ourselves and our daughter, to all the School policies that are presently applicable or which may in the future be introduced or implemented by the School from time to time.
